## VILLAGE OF ADDISON LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIVE FUND TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$23,710,927

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Addison, our lost revenue totals **\$23,710,927**.

## FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In Addison, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure and public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- LGDF revenue represents **12%** of our General Fund, supporting public safety salaries, General Government services, highways and streets, forestry, Addison Consolidated Dispatch, and the Henry Hyde Resource Center.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only 17.2% of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2011 and 2022, the State's total income tax (IT) receipts increased by 174%.


