# VILLAGE OF BENSENVILLE LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIVE FUND TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$11,901,012

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Bensenville, our lost revenue totals \$11,901,012.

#### **FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE**

In Bensenville, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure and public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- LGDF represents 12.7% of our General Fund Operating Budget.
- o In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only 14.7% of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2011 and 2022, the State's total income tax
  (IT) receipts increased by 174%.




#### **UNFUNDED PROJECTS**

- \$200,000 annually for Village-wide residential streetlight program.
- \$48,000 annually for squad car replacement.
- \$1.38 million for
  Water's Edge Aquatic
  Center renovations.

### **KEY FIGURES**

- \$15 million projected for lead service line replacement costs.
- \$1.76 million for public safety pensions in 2022 and increasing, with \$1.91 million budgeted for 2023.
- \$20,800 for police body camera implementation, and \$40,000 in annual labor costs.
