In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, LGDF is still not restored. In Bloomingdale, our lost revenue totals \$14,222,433.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In Bloomingdale, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure and public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- LGDF funds public safety salaries, general government services, street maintenance, urban forestry, stormwater, and code enforcement.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only **6.8%** of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2011 and 2022, the State's total income tax (IT) receipts increased by **174%**.


