**TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$7,115,278**

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Campton Hills, our lost revenue totals \$7,115,278.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY &  
INFRASTRUCTURE



In the Village of Campton Hills, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure and public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

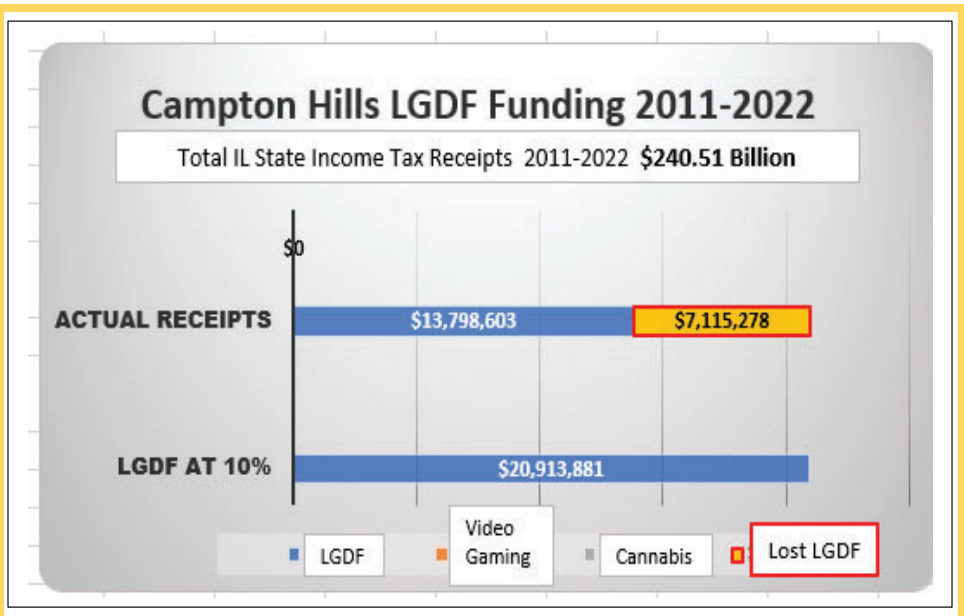
- Our public safety salaries are solely dependent on LGDF.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only **3.79%** of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State’s total income tax receipts increased by **195%**.

UNFUNDED PROJECTS

- Resurfacing of Town Hall Road
- Squad car replacement
- Addition of Code Enforcement staff and Public Safety staff

BY THE NUMBERS

- LGDF funds in excess of 50% of our operating budget.
- The Village invested over \$1.5 million to public safety programs in 2022.
- \$38,000 for police body camera implementation.
