In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Carol Stream, our lost revenue totals **\$25,607,056**.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In Carol Stream, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure and public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- LGDF revenue is allocated to the Village's General Fund, which supports public safety salaries, community development, and other Village essential services.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only 12.3% of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2011 and 2022, the State's total income tax (IT) receipts increased by 174%.
