EAST DUNDEE LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIVE FUND TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$1,828,020

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In East Dundee, our lost revenue totals \$1,828,020.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In East Dundee, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure and public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- 100% of LGDF funding is used to support General Fund operations, specifically for public safety salaries and benefits.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only 14% of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State's total income tax receipts increased by 195%.




UNFUNDED PROJECTS

- Limited the ability to fully fund Police Pension contribution.
- Delayed hiring additional personnel in various departments
- Postponed renovations to Village Hall.

BY THE NUMBERS

- LGDF represents 5% of our operating budget.
- \$726,107 annually for public safety pensions in 2022.
- Only \$50,000 for lead service line replacement with much more funding needed.
- \$20,000 for police body camera implementation.
