

ELK GROVE VILLAGE LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIVE FUND TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$20,960,839

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Elk Grove Village, our lost revenue totals **\$20,960,839**.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In Elk Grove Village, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure and public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- **25%** of LGDF goes to public safety salaries.
- **75%** of LGDF goes to infrastructure investments.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only **18%** of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State's total income tax receipts increased by **195%**.

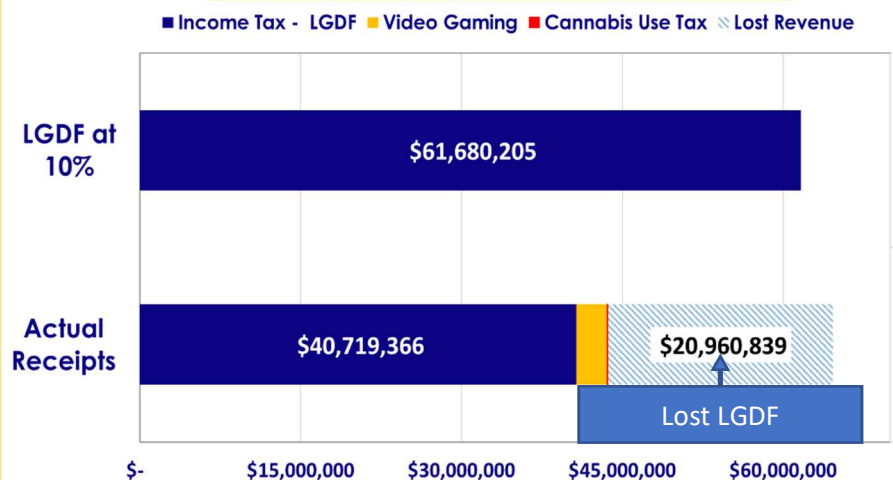
