In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, LGDF is still not restored. In Harvey, our lost revenue totals \$16,062,132.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In Harvey, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure and public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- 0% of Harvey's LGDF funding was invested in capital projects in 2022.
- 4% of our LGDF funding is used for public safety salaries.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only 9.8% of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State's total income tax receipts increased by 195%.
