MOUNT PROSPECT LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIVE FUND TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$34,423,218

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Mount Prospect, our lost revenue totals \$34,423,218.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & CRITICAL SERVICES

In Mount Prospect, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- 100% of LGDF goes to public safety salaries and other essential services.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only 6% of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State's total income tax receipts increased by 195%.




MISSED OPPORTUNITIES

Additional LGDF will allow the Village to fund capital projects without issuing new debt.

Additional LGDF will allow the Village to reduce our Property Tax Levy, especially pension levies.
