

BARRINGTON LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIVE FUND

TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$6,535,910

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Barrington, our lost revenue totals **\$6,535,910**.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In Barrington, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in services that our residents rely on every day.

- The General Assembly's limited action of the LGDF will restore only an estimated **\$219,000** over the next decade. A partial restoration could restore **\$5 million** for public safety, infrastructure and other critical priorities.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only **2%** of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State's total income tax receipts increased by **195%**.

- 1) Annual Road Program – \$1 million annually
- 2) Public Works facility – \$10 million
- 3) Deferred vehicle and equipment purchases – \$2 million

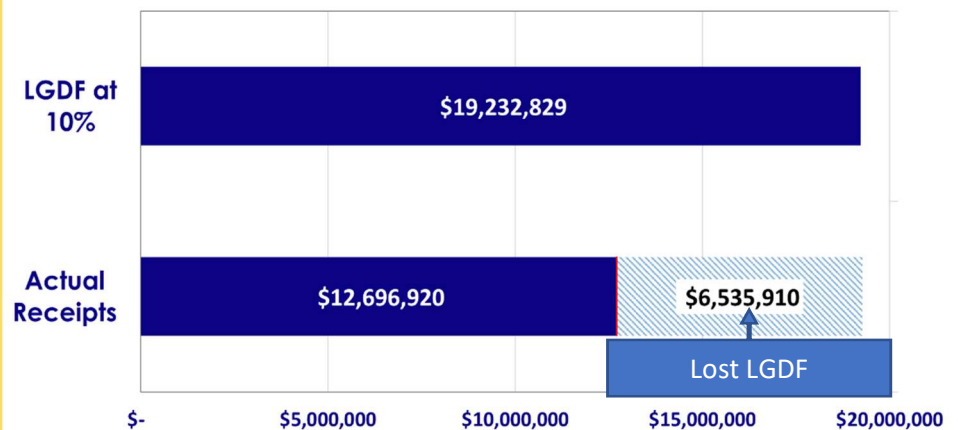
BY THE NUMBERS

- LGDF represents **3.9%** of our operating budget.
- **\$2,096,547** for public safety pensions in most recent fiscal year.
- **\$16 to 20 million** for lead service line replacement.
- **\$100,000** for police body cameras (5-year cost).
