

DEER PARK LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIVE FUND

TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$2,042,364

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Deer Park, our lost revenue totals **\$2,042,364**.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In Deer Park, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure and public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- The General Assembly's limited action of the LGDF will restore only an estimated **\$72,876** over the next decade. A partial restoration could restore **\$1.7 million** for critical priorities.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only **2%** of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State's total income tax receipts increased by **195%**.



UNFUNDED PROJECTS

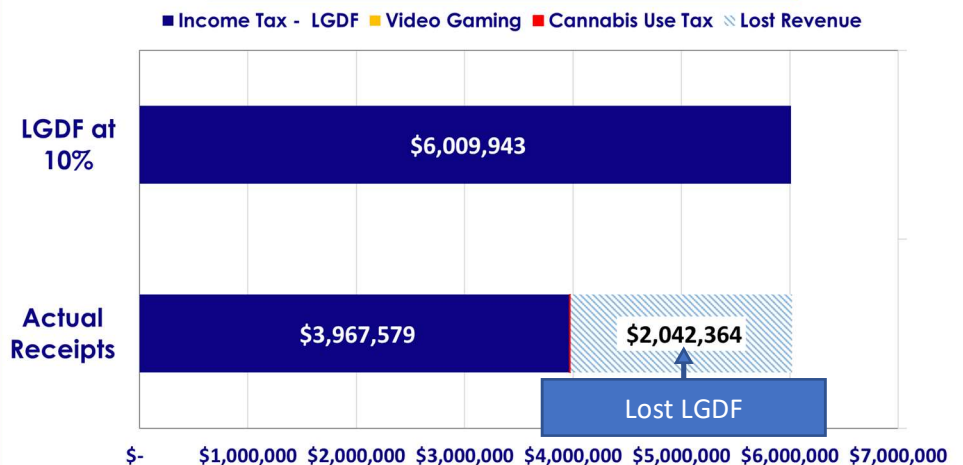
Restored LGDF funding would help the Village accelerate its roads and drainage construction improvements plan as well as complete park improvements that have been delayed.

BY THE NUMBERS

- LGDF represents **14%** of our FY 23 operating budget.
- LGDF funds approximately **30%** of essential Village police services, our largest expense, which is externally contracted with the Lake County Sheriff.
