

DEERFIELD LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIVE FUND

TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$11,699,140

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Deerfield, our lost revenue totals **\$11,699,140**.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In Deerfield, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- **100%** of LGDF goes to public safety salaries.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax revenue made up only **2%** of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels. The Village does not receive any revenue from video gaming.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State's total income tax receipts increased by **195%**.

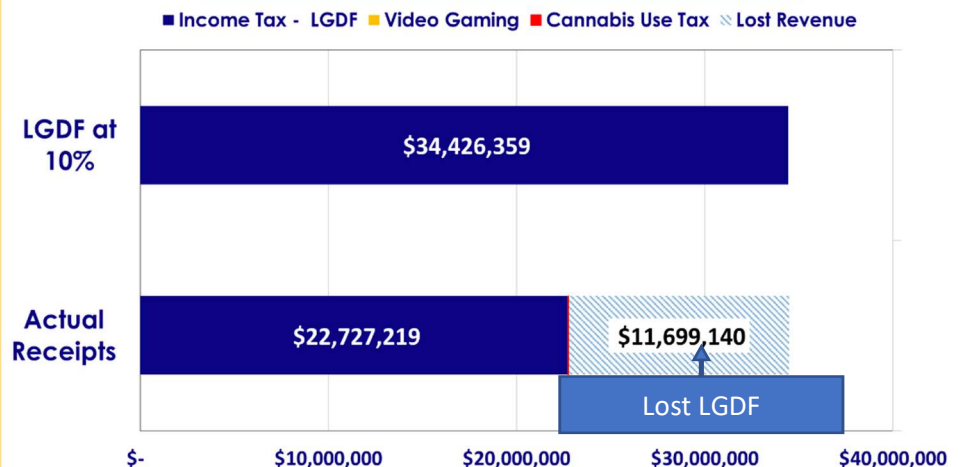
1. Arbor Vitae Rd infrastructure project

BY THE NUMBERS

- **4%** LGDF represents of our operating budget.
- **\$1,100,000** for public safety pensions in most recent fiscal year.
- **\$4,000,000** for lead service line replacement.
- **\$375,000** for police body cameras (5-year cost).
