

# GLENVIEW LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIVE FUND

## TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$28,882,042

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Glenview, our lost revenue totals **\$28,882,042**.

### FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In Glenview, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure and public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- **36%** of LGDF goes to public safety salaries.
- **12%** of LGDF goes to infrastructure projects.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax revenue made up only **2%** of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels. The Village does not receive any revenue from video gaming.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State's total income tax receipts increased by **195%**.

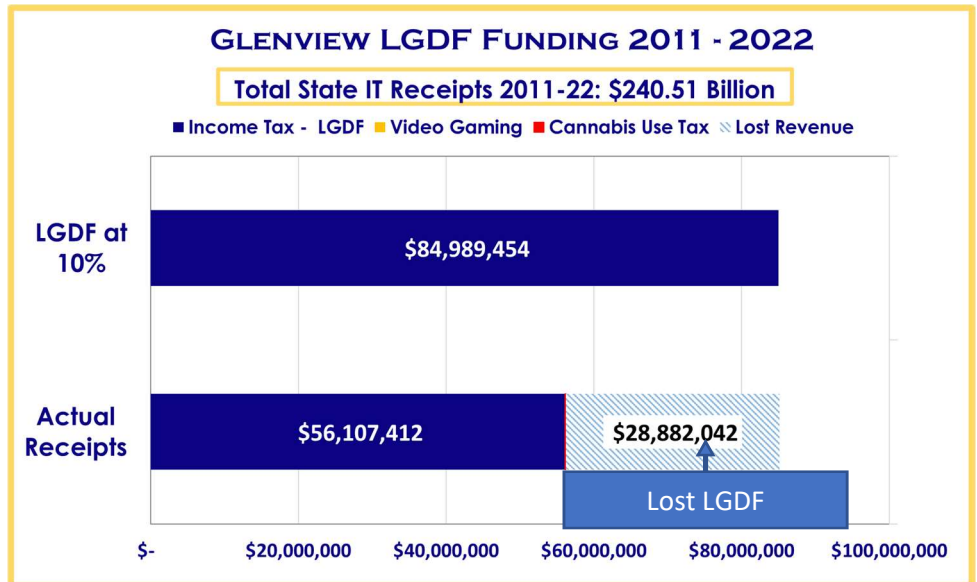


#### DELAYED PROJECTS

- Shermer Road resurfacing from Golf Road to Lake Ave - \$3 million
- Sequoia Rd (Tall Trees) reconstruction and culvert pipe replacement - \$4 million
- Glenview Road resurfacing from Milwaukee to Washington St. - \$2 million

### BY THE NUMBERS

- LGDF represents **9%** our operating budget.
- **\$9,469,391** for public safety pensions in most recent fiscal year.
- **\$5-10 million** for lead service line replacement.
- **\$340,627** for police body cameras (5-year cost).
