

# GRAYSLAKE LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIVE FUND

## TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$13,204,565

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Grayslake, our lost revenue totals **\$13,204,565**.

### FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In Grayslake, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure and public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- **43%** of LGDF goes to public safety salaries.
- **57%** of LGDF goes to infrastructure projects.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only **2%** of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State's total income tax receipts increased by **195%**.

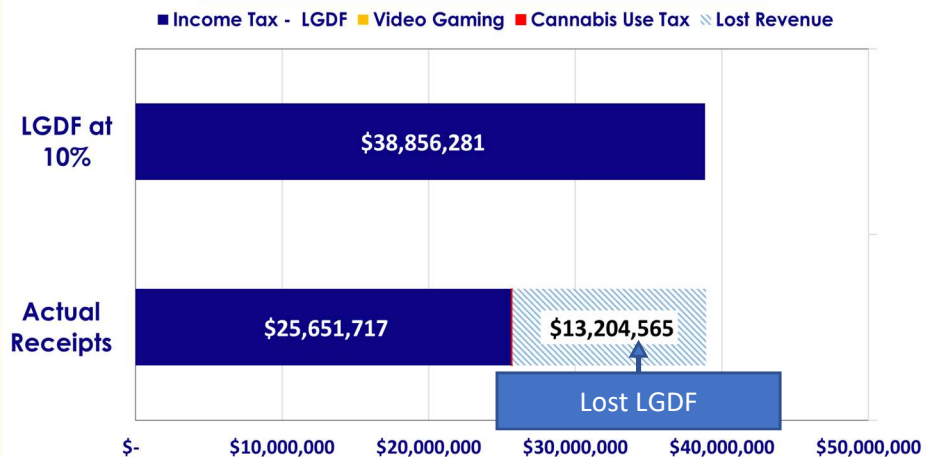
- Harvey Ave. Watermain Replacement: \$1,156,000

### BY THE NUMBERS

- LGDF represents **43%** of our operating budget.
- **\$995,000** for police pensions in most recent fiscal year.
- **\$2,400,000** for lead service line replacement.
- **\$510,000** for police body cameras (5-year cost).
