

LINCOLNWOOD LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIVE FUND

TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$7,987,414

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Lincolnwood, our lost revenue totals **\$7,987,414**.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In Lincolnwood, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure and public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- **50.5%** of LGDF goes to public safety salaries.
- **40%** of LGDF goes to public safety salaries.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only **2%** of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State's total income tax receipts increased by **195%**.



UNFUNDED PROJECTS

- 1) Stormwater Improvements - \$33.6 million
- 2) Police and public works vehicles - \$50,000 to \$200,000
- 3) Deferred roof replacement of municipal buildings & facility improvements - \$550,000
- 4) Deferred municipal building generator - \$350,000

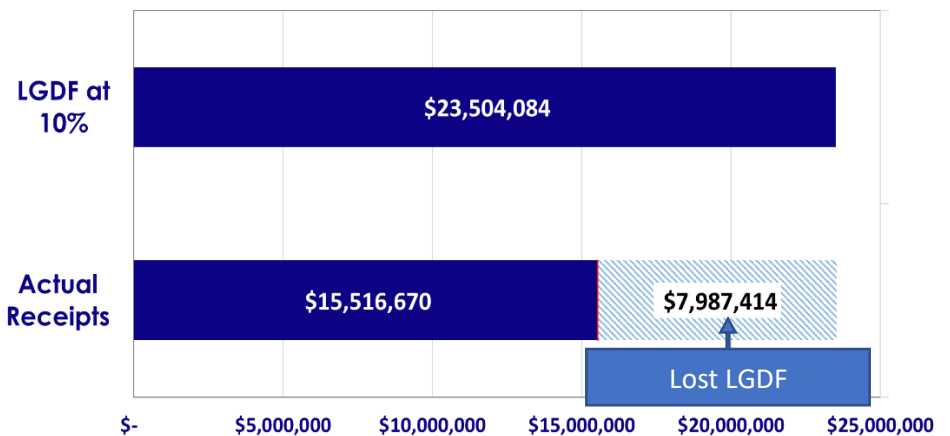
BY THE NUMBERS

- **8.1%** LGDF represents of our operating budget.
- **\$2,566,215** for public safety pensions in most recent fiscal year.
- **\$16,300,000** for lead service line replacement.
- **\$244,000** for police body cameras (5-year cost).
