
TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$7,987,414

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Lincolnwood, our lost revenue totals \$7,987,414.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In Lincolnwood, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure and public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- o 50.5% of LGDF goes to public safety salaries.
- 40% of LGDF goes to public safety salaries.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only 2% of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State's total income tax receipts increased by 195%.




UNFUNDED PROJECTS

- 1) Stormwater Improvements \$33.6 million
- 2) Police and public works vehicles \$50,000 to \$200,000
- 3) Deferred roof replacement of municipal buildings & facility improvements \$550,000
- 4) Deferred municipal building generator \$350,000

- 8.1% LGDF represents of our operating budget.
- \$2,566,215 for public safety pensions in most recent fiscal year.
- o \$16,300,000 for lead service line replacement.
- o **\$244,000** for police body cameras (5-year cost).
