

MORTON GROVE LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIVE FUND

TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$14,770,320

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Morton Grove, our lost revenue totals **\$14,770,320**.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In Morton Grove, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure and public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- **50%** of LGDF goes to public safety salaries.
- **25%** of LGDF goes to infrastructure investment.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only **20%** of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State's total income tax receipts increased by **195%**.



UNFUNDED PROJECTS

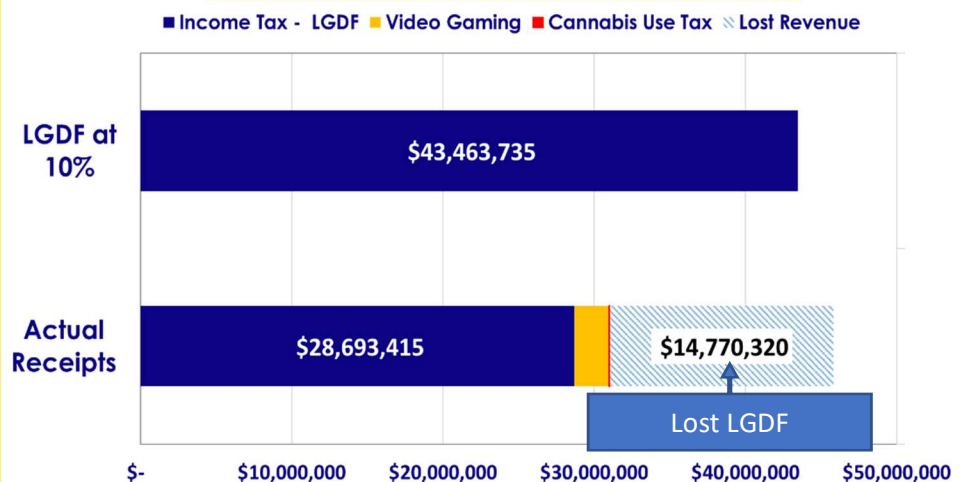
- One (1) mile of street resurfacing annually.
- 1,700 feet (1/3 mile) of water/sewer replacement annually.
- Facility maintenance - roofs & mechanical needs.

BY THE NUMBERS

- LGDF represents **10%** of our operating budget.
- **\$6,073,986** in public safety pension contributions in most recent fiscal year.
- **\$15,260,000** for lead service line replacement (estimated cost).
- **\$303,872** for police body cameras (5-year cost estimate).
