NORTHBROOK LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIVE FUND TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$21,099,764

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Northbrook, our lost revenue totals **\$21,099,764**.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In Northbrook, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure and public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- **50**% of LGDF goes to public safety salaries.
- 36% of LGDF is invested in capital projects.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only 2% of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State's total income tax receipts increased by 195%.




UNFUNDED PROJECTS
