PALATINE LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIVE FUND TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$43,214,642

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Palatine, our lost revenue totals **\$43,214,642**.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In Palatine, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure that our residents rely on every day.

- o **50%** of LGDF goes to infrastructure investments.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only 1.6% of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State's total income tax receipts increased by **195**%.


