

PALATINE LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIVE FUND

TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$43,214,642

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Palatine, our lost revenue totals **\$43,214,642**.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In Palatine, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure that our residents rely on every day.

- **50%** of LGDF goes to infrastructure investments.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only **1.6%** of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State's total income tax receipts increased by **195%**.



UNFUNDED PROJECTS

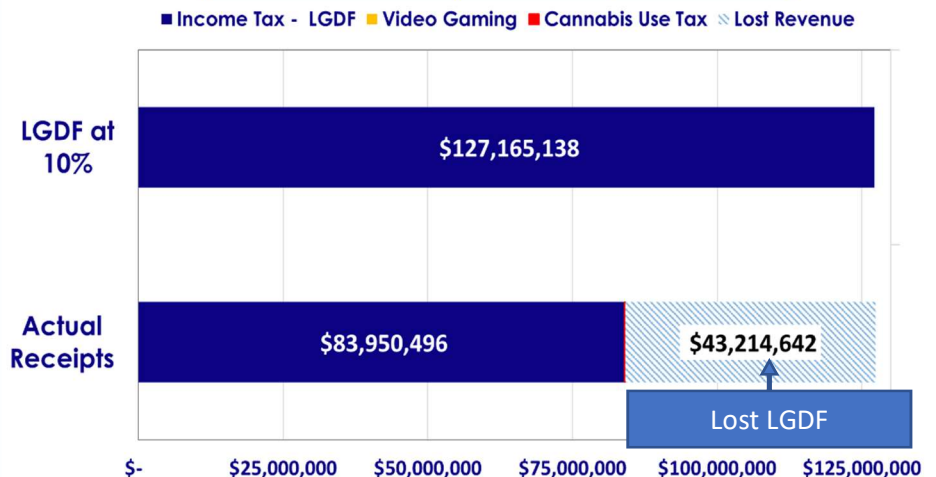
- Creek Bank Stabilization and Flood Control - \$5 million.
- Public Works Facility Modernization - \$15 million.

BY THE NUMBERS

- LGDF represents **50%** of our operating budget.
- **\$11,125,000** for public safety pensions in most recent fiscal year.
- **\$5,000,000** for lead service line replacement.
- **\$750,000** for police body cameras (5-year cost).
