

PROSPECT HEIGHTS LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIVE FUND TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$10,285,040

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Prospect Heights, our lost revenue totals **\$10,285,040**.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In Prospect Heights, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure and public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- **24%** of LGDF goes to public safety salaries.
- Before the reduction in LGDF, **25%** of LGDF went to infrastructure investment.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only **23%** of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State's total income tax receipts increased by **195%**.

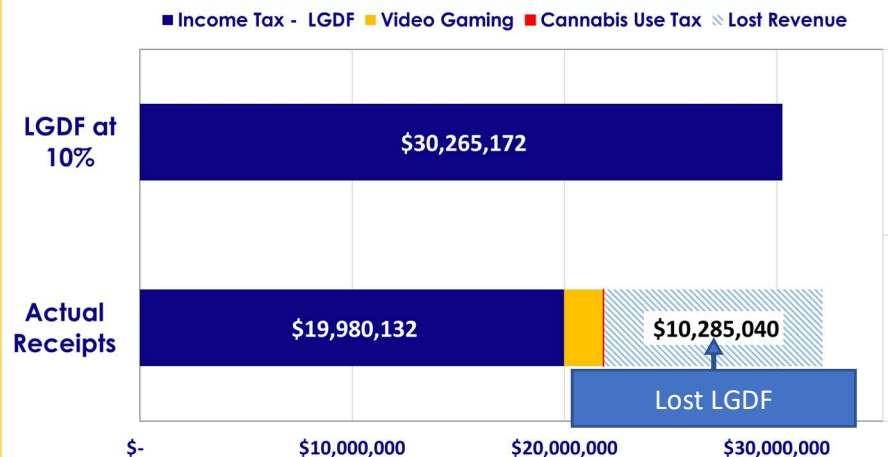
- 1) Hiring of more Police Officers and increasing Detectives - \$286,400
- 2) Storm Water management projects - \$5,950,000
- 3) Sidewalk extension projects. \$4,200,000

BY THE NUMBERS

- LGDF represents **7.6%** of our operating budget.
- **\$997,013** for public safety pensions in most recent fiscal year.
- **\$119,187** for police body cameras (5-year cost).
