ROLLING MEADOWS LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIVE FUND TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$15,241,389

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Rolling Meadows, our lost revenue totals \$15,241,389.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY

In Rolling Meadows, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- **100**% of LGDF goes to public safety salaries.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only 11% of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State's total income tax receipts increased by 195%.
