

SKOKIE LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIVE FUND

TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$41,014,848

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Skokie, our lost revenue totals **\$41,014,848**.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY

In Skokie, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- **46%** of LGDF goes to public safety salaries.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only **2%** of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State's total income tax receipts increased by **195%**.



UNFUNDED PROJECTS

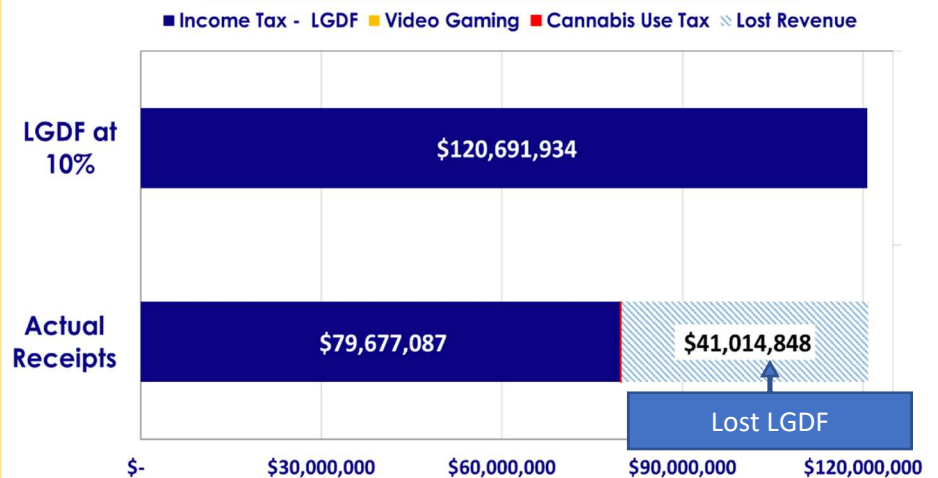
1. Lead Service Line Replacement - \$79 million
2. Austin Avenue Improvements - \$5 million
3. Gross Point Road Reconstruction from Main to Church St - \$2.5 million.

BY THE NUMBERS

- LGDF represents **12%** of our operating budget.
- **\$20,943,993** for public safety pensions in most recent fiscal year.
- **\$79,000,000** for lead service line replacement.
- **\$2,000,375** for police body cameras (5-year cost).
