# Wheeling Local Government Distributive Fund TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$23,885,017

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Wheeling, our lost revenue totals \$23,885,017.

### **FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY**

In Wheeling, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the public safety services that our residents rely on every day.




- 64% of LGDF goes to public safety salaries.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only 13% of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State's total income tax receipts increased by 195%.

#### UNFUNDED PROJECTS

The Village has postponed hiring more firefighters needed to meet the increased demand for ambulance service.

- LGDF represents 12% of our operating budget.
- \$6,394,501 for public safety pensions in most recent fiscal year.
- o \$140,000 for police body cameras (5-year cost).
