

# VILLAGE OF OAK BROOK LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIVE FUND

## TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$5,113,178

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Oak Brook, our lost revenue totals **\$5,113,178**.

### FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In Oak Brook, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure and public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- LGDF revenue is allocated to the Village's General Fund expenses, supporting staff salaries, police, fire, and other daily Village operations.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax revenue made up only **1.6%** of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels. Oak Brook does not collect video gaming revenue.
- Between 2011 and 2022, the State's total income tax (IT) receipts increased by **174%**.



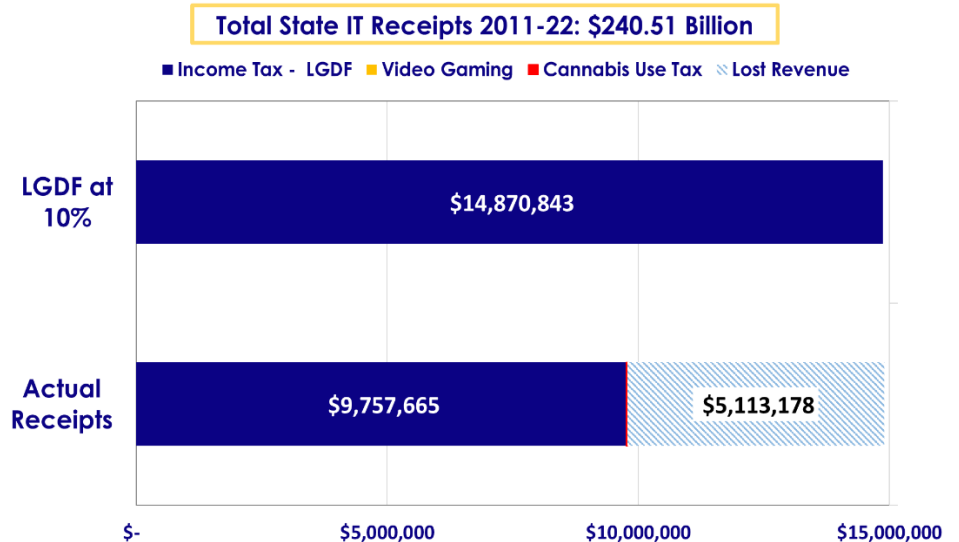
### UNFUNDED PROJECTS

### KEY FIGURES

- LGDF represents **4%** of our General Fund Operating Budget.
- **\$4.3 million** was allocated for public safety pensions in the FY2022 budget.
- **\$76,245** is budgeted for police body camera implementation.
