TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$3,154,458

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Pingree Grove our lost revenue totals \$3,154,458.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In Pingree Grove, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure and public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- o 30% of LGDF funding is invested in capital projects.
- 64% of our LGDF funding is used for public safety salaries.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only 14% of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State's total income tax receipts increased by 195%.



- LGDF represents 55% of our operating budget.
