RICHTON PARK, IL-LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIVE FUND TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$8,731,019

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Richton Park, our lost revenue totals **\$8,731,019**.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In Richton Park, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure and public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- 12% of Richton Park's LGDF funding is invested in capital projects.
- 88% of our LGDF funding is used for public safety salaries.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only 6.3% of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State's total income tax receipts increased by 195%.


