

RIGHTON PARK, IL - LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIVE FUND

TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$8,731,019

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Richton Park, our lost revenue totals **\$8,731,019**.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In Richton Park, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure and public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- **12%** of Richton Park's LGDF funding is invested in capital projects.
- **88%** of our LGDF funding is used for public safety salaries.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only **6.3%** of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State's total income tax receipts increased by **195%**.



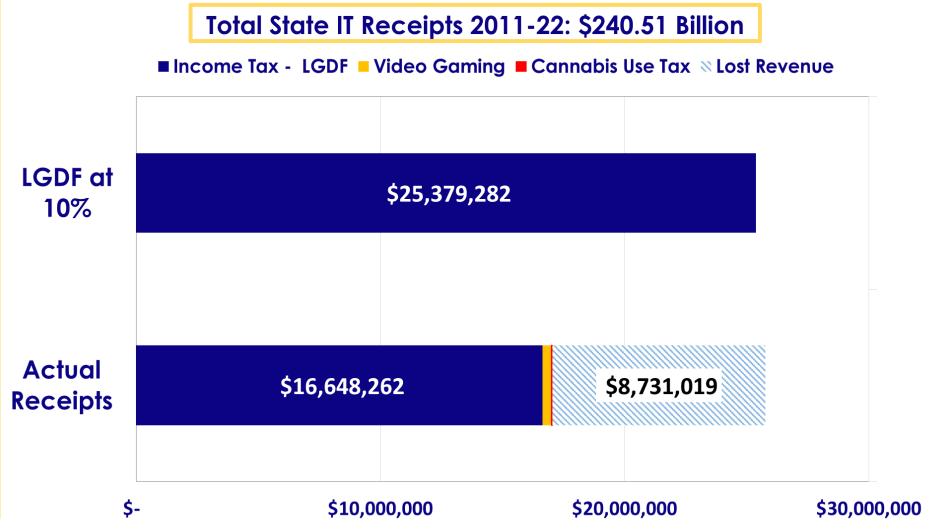
UNFUNDED PROJECTS

- Transportation Projects: Road Resurfacing, Transit Improvements
- Water Infrastructure: Water Main Replacement, Fire Hydrants, Sewers
- Police Cars, Body Cameras, Equipment

BY THE NUMBERS

- LGDF represents **16%** of our operating budget.
- **\$1,283,904** annually for public safety pensions (39% of levy in 2021).
- **\$29,600,000** for lead service line replacement.
- **\$35,000** for police body camera implementation.
