TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$20,820,643

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In St. Charles, our lost revenue totals **\$20,820,643**.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In St. Charles, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is ultimately invested in police and fire public safety services and related infrastructure that our residents rely on every day.

- **32%** of funding for St. Charles salaries for police and fire comes from LGDF Funding
- Annually, cannabis use tax revenue only makes up approximately **3.5%** of the difference between current and promised LGDF funding levels and video gaming revenues only make up an additional **26%** of promised LGDF funding
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State's total income tax receipts increased by **195%**.



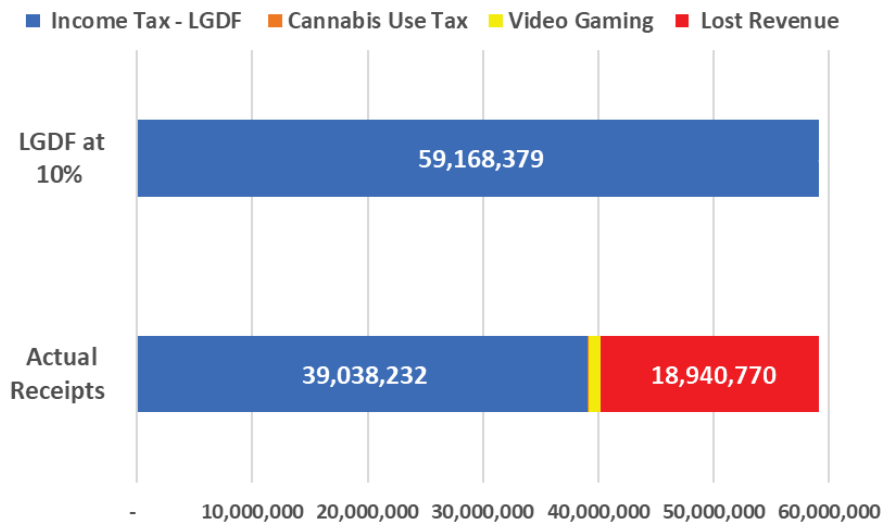
UNFUNDED PROJECTS

BY THE NUMBERS

- LGDF represents **7.8%** of our General Fund budget.
- Current General Fund budget of **\$54.6 million** necessary to support public services including police, fire and public works.
- Annual lost revenue equivalent of **13 full-time workers**
