

# STREAMWOOD LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIVE FUND TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$23,292,888

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Streamwood, our lost revenue totals **\$23,292,888**.

## FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In Streamwood, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure and public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- **50%** of LGDF goes to public safety salaries.
- **50%** of LGDF goes to infrastructure investments.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only **12%** of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State's total income tax receipts increased by **195%**.



### MISSED OPPORTUNITIES

Streamwood lives within its means and find ways to balance our budgets on an annual basis. Restored LGDF would assist the Village in meeting obligations while reducing stress on other revenue streams.

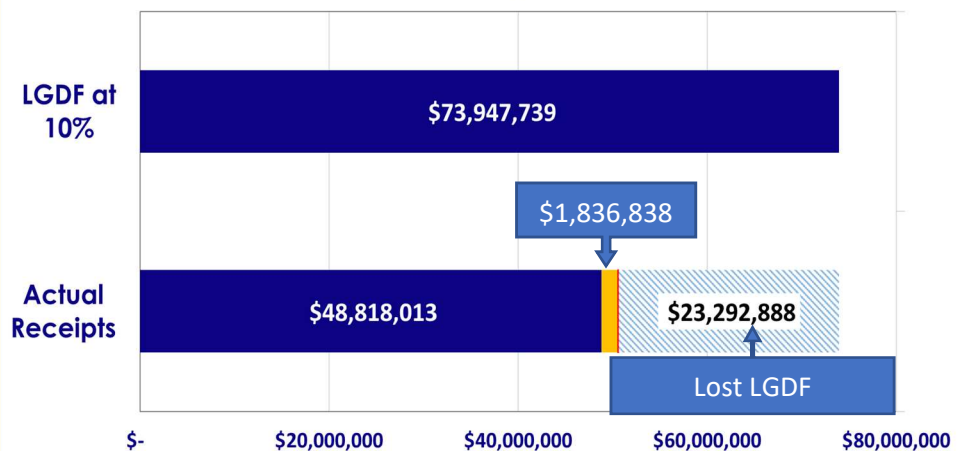
## BY THE NUMBERS

- LGDF represents **15%** of our operating budget.
- **\$4,856,276** for public safety pensions in most recent fiscal year.
- **\$325,000** for police body cameras (5-year cost).
