

VILLAGE OF SUGAR GROVE LGDF

TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$5,591,467

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Sugar Grove, our lost revenue totals **\$5,591,467**.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In Sugar Grove, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure and public safety services that our residents rely on every day.



- **100%** of our LGDF funding is used for public safety salaries.
- The loss in funding to our community annually equates to hiring an additional **two (2) full-time police officers** and **\$100,000** lost annually toward Capital Infrastructure.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State's total income tax receipts increased by **195%**.

UNFUNDED PROJECTS

- Hiring of Additional Police Officers.
- Police Department Building public safety upgrades.

BY THE NUMBERS

- LGDF represents **17.44%** of our operating budget.
- Cannabis & Video Gaming only make up **1.5%** of our operating budget,
- **\$675,160** annually for public safety pensions in 2022.
- **\$54,000** for police body camera implementation.
