In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, LGDF is still not restored. In Wayne, our lost revenue totals \$1,519,115.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In the Village of Wayne, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure and public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- o 37.9% of Wayne's LGDF funding is invested in capital projects.
- **34%** of our LGDF funding is used for public safety salaries.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only **1.6%** of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2011 and 2022, the State's total income tax (IT) receipts increased by 174%.
