

YORKVILLE, ILLINOIS LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIVE FUND

TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$11,415,335

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Yorkville, our lost revenue totals **\$11,415,335**.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In Yorkville, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure and public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- **27%** of Yorkville’s LGDF funding is invested in capital projects.
- **73%** of our LGDF funding is used for public safety salaries.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only **16.5%** of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State’s total income tax receipts increased by **195%**.



UNFUNDED PROJECTS

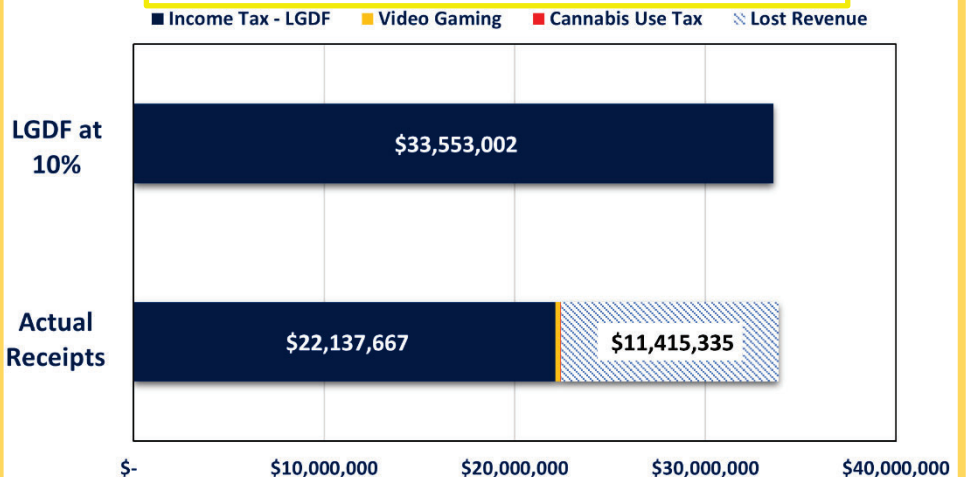
- Baseline Road – primary distributor road to IL Route 47 and IL Route 30.
- East Van Emmon Street – collector road providing access to City’s Downtown.
- Alice Avenue – collector road providing access to IL Rte 47.

BY THE NUMBERS

- LGDF represents **14%** of our operating budget.
- **\$2,313,000** annually for public safety pensions in 2022.
- **\$860,000** for City Road Program in 2022.
- **\$150,000** for police body camera implementation.
