BUFFALO GROVE LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIVE FUND TOTAL LOST REVENUE: \$26,356,211

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. In Buffalo Grove, our lost revenue totals **\$26,356,211**.

FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & INFRASTRUCTURE

In Buffalo Grove, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue is invested in the infrastructure and public safety services that our residents rely on every day.

- **7**% of LGDF goes to public safety salaries.
- 4.3% of LGDF goes to infrastructure investments.
- In 2022, cannabis use tax and video gaming revenue made up only 4.8% of the difference between our current and promised LGDF funding levels.
- Between 2009 and 2022, the State's total income tax receipts increased by 195%.




MISSED OPPORTUNITIES

- Pave 2.5 miles of street annually, totaling 40 percent of the Village's annual need.
- Offset 34 percent of public safety pension contributions coming from local property taxpayers, reducing the Village's annual tax levy by 9.3 percent.
- Complete all of the Village's prioritized stormwater master plan projects, providing relief from current and future storm water management issues.

- \$5,818,162 for public safety pensions in most recent fiscal year.
- o \$418,000 for police body camera (5-year cost).
