

Village of Pingree Grove Local Government Distributive Fund

Total Lost Revenue: \$5,717,929

In 2011, the General Assembly reduced the percentage of income tax revenue that is allocated to local governments, promising that these cuts would be a temporary shared sacrifice. Over a decade later, **LGDF** is still not restored. Our community's lost revenue totals **\$5.7 million** to date.

Serving Residents & Businesses

In Pingree Grove, Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue, which is generated from income taxes on our residents & businesses, is invested in the infrastructure and public safety services that our community relies on every day.

- LGDF revenue, including an additional **\$101,122** from the FY24 increase to **6.47%**, helped fund a new \$9 million Water Treatment Plant and \$73 million Wastewater Treatment Plant in our community.
- Our community would lose an estimated **\$18,279** each year by eliminating the state sales tax on groceries.
- Police body camera implementation costs **\$38,377**.
- Our community received only **\$156,442** in video gaming revenue in FY23, which is **9.7%** of our LGDF revenue.



Essential Revenue

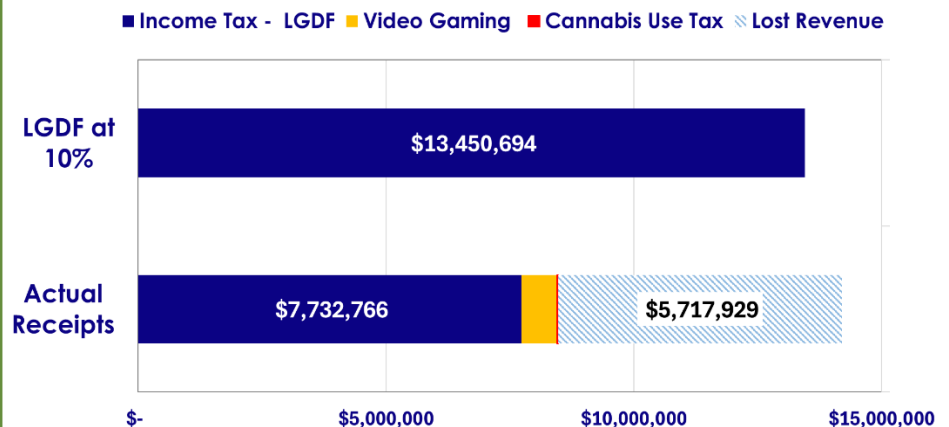
- LGDF represents **35.2%** of our FY24 general fund revenues.
- As costs continue to grow, LGDF reduces pressure on property taxes & other revenue.

Pension Impacts

- In 2023, public safety pensions contributions cost **\$244,624**, which is **39.9%** of our municipal property tax levy.
- To date, our total lost LGDF revenue could have funded our contributions to public safety pensions for **23 years**.
